## WOMEN & GIRLS CRICKET

Scarborough Cricket Club are on a mission to create a women & girls section at North Marine Road with the first step on an exciting initiative to recruit a team of coaches and team managers along with a 'head of women & girls cricket'.

There's already been some strong interest from within the local area. Cricket Committee Secretary Ann Snowball mentioned to her next door neighbour what the club were doing, "she has never been involved in cricket before, but has a sporting background and wants to get involved in helping get this off the ground and take part in the organisation at the club over the next few years".

Women & girls cricket is certainly a major growth area within the sport, with 60,000 estimated to have been participating back in 2014. Through the 'Chance to shine' scheme a large number of girls have been given access to the sport via school visits from qualified coaches.

It's a fast growing area within cricket, and one which Scarborough Cricket Club are very keen to be involved. Cricket Chairman Graham Clark, a qualified ECB level II coach explained where the club are with recruitment – "we've got a number of girls already at the club, but not enough to create a team. However, before we can move that forward we do need a strong qualified coaching team and support volunteers. We have already had some interest in this area, and have one really good person already on board, but we do need others so that we can provide quality coaching".

"You don't have to hold a qualification to be involved. The club will work with potential coaches to help and support them gain the relevant coaching qualification. We want to encourage and support more women to complete coaching qualifications", explains Emma Hopper, the club's Community Engagement Manager. "We want to develop current opportunities for women and girls of all ages and abilities to participate in cricket".
